## AQF VET qualification

To attain Certificate II in Sawmilling and Processing (FPI20305) students must achieve 13 units of competency including:

- a) 5 core units of competency
- b) 3 group A elective units of competency
- c) 5 group A and/or B elective units of competency
  - which can include up to 2 units from a relevant Certificate II or III from an endorsed Training Package or State/Territory accredited course.
