AQF VET qualification

To attain Certificate III in Cabinet Making (LMF32109) students must achieve 27 units of competency including:

- a) 6 mandatory units of competency
- b) 18 specialist units of competency
 - a minimum of 8 units of competency from Groups 2A and 2C or Groups 2B and 2C
 - the balance of units of competency from any combination from Groups 2A, 2B, 2C and 2D
- c) 3 other elective units of competency – any combination from Groups 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D and other units in the LMF02 Training Package (may include up to one from Certificate IV level and one from Certificate II level).
