### HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

#### Horse Racing Industry (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all units of competency in Group 1.

#### Horse Racing Industry Extension (60 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 1 unit at the Preliminary or HSC level
- attempt one unit of competency from Group 2.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

### AQF VET credential

To attain Certificate I in Racing (Stablehand) (RGR10108) students must achieve:

- 4 core units of competency
- 1 optional elective unit if seeking driving or riding skills.
