Plumbing (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt CPCPCM2003A and elective units of competency to a minimum of 105 HSC indicative hours.

Plumbing (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt CPCPCM2003A and elective units of competency to a minimum of 225 HSC indicative hours.

Plumbing (360 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 6 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt CPCPCM2003A and elective units of competency to a minimum of 345 HSC indicative hours.

To count a course towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

The pattern of study entered should reflect the delivery of the course over successive years. Students will be credentialled for the HSC unit credit entered each calendar year provided they have satisfactorily completed the course requirements for that calendar year as determined by the school/RTO.

To attain Certificate III in Plumbing (CPC32408) students must achieve:

- a) Stream 1 Water (23 compulsory and 6 elective units of competency from the water stream)
- b) Stream 2 Sanitary (6 compulsory and 4 elective units of competency from the sanitary stream)
- c) two (2) of the other four (4) streams (Drainage, Mechanical services, Roofing, Gas services).

Note: Units of competency achieved in one stream count as credit for the same unit in the compulsory or elective requirements for any other stream.
