Minimum work placement
Students undertaking the Theatre and Screen Performance (120 hours) course are required to participate in at least one production event for public performance. Students undertaking the Theatre and Screen Performance (240 or 360 hours) course are required to participate in at least two production events for public performance.

Exclusions
Stage 6 Drama A number of Board Developed HSC courses include a requirement for the development of project work for either internal or external assessment. Projects or products developed as part of HSC VET courses are not to be used either in full or in part for assessment in any other HSC course.

HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Theatre and Screen Performance (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all compulsory units of competency and elective units of competency to a minimum of 95 HSC indicative hours.

Theatre and Screen Performance (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all compulsory units of competency and elective units of competency to a minimum of 215 HSC indicative hours.

Theatre and Screen Performance (360 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 6 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all compulsory units of competency and elective units of competency to a minimum of 235 HSC indicative hours.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

The pattern of study entered should reflect the delivery of the course over successive years. Students will be credentialled for the HSC unit credit entered each calendar year provided they have satisfactorily completed the course requirements for that calendar year as determined by the school/RTO.
